

Michael J. David-Wilson - Chief Executive Officer



Michael J. David-Wilson, of Mays Landing, joined The Arc of Atlantic County as Chief Executive Officer in March 2013. He brings more than two decades of successful experience in nonprofit executive and senior management to The Arc. He is a seasoned fundraising professional and has raised more than \$30 million in philanthropic support during his career.

David-Wilson most recently served as president and CEO of Brunswick Senior Resources Incorporated (BSRI), a county-based organization that provides senior and nutrition services throughout Brunswick County in North Carolina. He managed nine sites and nearly 250 staff and volunteers. Before moving to North Carolina, David-Wilson lived and worked in New Jersey for 22 years. He served as Executive Director of Middlesex County College Foundation in Edison, NJ where he led the Foundation for seven years, managing and growing its multi-million dollar financial aid and scholarship endowment. He also worked at the North Jersey Community Research Initiative in Newark, NJ in various roles including Director of Institutional Advancement and directed a \$6.5 million capital campaign. He served for 11 years as Founder and Director of The AIDS Center at Hope House (Catholic Social Services of Morris County) with offices in Morris, Sussex and Warren Counties, securing millions of dollars in funding to establish and grow comprehensive HIV specific psychosocial services.

David-Wilson is keenly aware of the funding challenges The Arc faces and is eager to address them. “Unfortunately the ongoing and growing needs of people with I/DD and their loved ones and caregivers do not fluctuate with changes in funding. I look forward to working together with The Arc’s Board of Directors, Executive Team, staff, key stake-holders and elected officials. Together I am confident we can ensure continuity of and appropriate growth for the comprehensive services today’s and tomorrow’s citizens with disabilities need in Atlantic County.

David-Wilson holds a Bachelor of Arts in philosophy with emphasis in psychology and theology from St. Alphonsus College in CT; a Master of Theological Studies from Washington Theological Union in Maryland; and a Graduate Certificate in Nonprofit Organization Management from Seton Hall University in NJ. He is a Certified Fund Raising Executive and a Certified Social Worker.

Along with his wife Dottie, David-Wilson is a member of the US Coast Guard Auxiliary and enjoys boating, attending concerts and shows, and spending time with their daughter and her husband who reside in Somerville.
